One of the baddest Sisters in the Party to me was Marsha, she worked out of the SF office and National HQ's became the OD (Officer of the Day) first Sister to hold that job. She was recruited into the Party @15years of age by Bobby Seale. Bobby first met her when she was the President of the BSU at Berkeley High in 1968.

She was a strong Sister, she could do anything any brother could do and better, a good shot, had great weapons knowledge, was very friendly, always willing to work. She can be seen In the video "Off the Pig": singing Free Huey. Marsha was send to Europe and other countries to represent the BPP.

I remember in 1969 when Sam Naiper took about 20 of the best paper sellers to the Monterrey Jazz Festival, all the brothers sold papers and the sisters was the security, in which Marsha was in charge of, she packed a Browning 15 shots in her purse and she wore a pair of Hot Pants that day she was hot on fire..

Marsha died in 1970, I will always remember her, she would say "Brother Love what's going On."
